

The Wine

Strawberries, black cherry and red currant dominate, while cola and plum skin mingle with spices and hint of licorice. Berry compote laced with vanilla carry through with a swirl. The palate is polished and supple with good fruit texture and unobtrusive tannins. 2011 is a soft vintage allowing for great early drinkability, but with enough freshness to age gracefully.

The Winemaking

Sourced from Lawrence Vineyards, harvested October 22, October 25, November 3, 2011, (Block 8 Cab Cl. 6, Block 4 Syrah Sara Lee, Block 11 Merlot Cl. 15).

Aged in new & neutral French oak. Bottled on April 2013.

The Vineyard

Lawrence Vineyards is the estate vineyard that produces all of the wine grapes for Gård wines and other premium wineries in Washington state. Lawrence Vineyards is located in the Columbia Valley AVA on the picturesque Frenchman Hills. Vineyard elevation (1,365-1,675 ft.) and a southern-facing slope provide ideal conditions for growing fine wine grapes.
