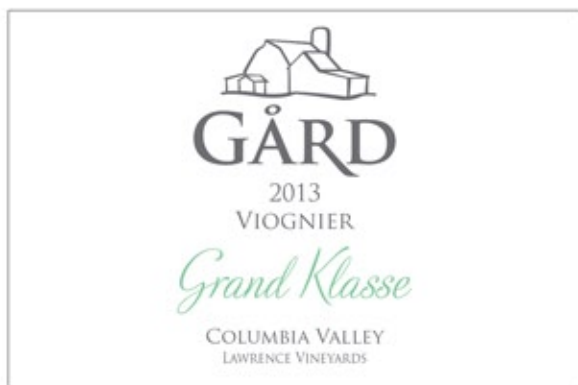

### The Wine

The first ever Grand Klasse reserve Viognier showcases Viognier's ability to be rich and vibrant. Notes of caramel, ripe peaches, citrus, white tea and a resinous spice. The palate is luxurious and creamy, with lemon curd, crème brulee and a fresh citrus-driven finish that has great lift. It has the texture to be consumed now, but like all the Grand Klasse wines, it is crafted to be enjoyed for years, rather than months, to come. This wine is unfinned and unfiltered.

### The Winemaking

Sourced from Lawrence Vineyards, harvested October 2012, Aged in 64% new French oak, unfinned & unfiltered.

### The Grand Klasse Reserve Label

Inspired by the French Grand Cru wines, Gard "Grand Klasse" is our reserve-level program, aptly named in reflection of our Scandinavian heritage. It represents the top tier of Gard wines, the best of what our estate vineyard has to offer. Award-winning wines produced by winemaker Aryn Morell to showcase the quality of the Lawrence Vineyards estate. To be designated "Grand Klasse," each wine must meet strict standards of quality and is blended, bottled and aged with the utmost of care to bring you the very best of our grapes and effort in the bottle.

### The Winery

Gård, meaning "farm" in many of the Scandinavian languages, is a tribute to our family's Scandinavian heritage and farming tradition. Gård Vintners is a family-owned and operated winery that seeks to capture the quality of their estate vineyard in the glass.

### The Vineyard

Lawrence Vineyards is the estate vineyard that produces all of the wine grapes for Gard wines and other premium wineries in Washington state. Lawrence Vineyards is located in the Columbia Valley AVA on the picturesque Frenchman Hills. Vineyard elevation (1,365-1,675 ft.) and a southern-facing slope provide ideal conditions for growing fine wine grapes.
